Independent Study credit is granted <u>only</u> for projects completed outside the College's regular course structure that have demonstrated academic value and will result in a body of work that will be assessed by a Bard College faculty member. This credit may not be earned for paid work. Proposals must be approved by a faculty sponsor, your adviser, the Dean of Studies, and the Faculty Executive Committee. Independent study projects may be undertaken in the fall or spring semester for up to four credits as part of the normal course load or during the January intersession or the summer for a maximum of two

credits. Summer and January Independent Study projects are limited to 2 credits. A fee per credit will be billed by student accounts upon registration.
